Acclaim Extra	Fenoxaprop-p-ethyl	<p><u>Statement of Practical Treatment:</u> If swallowed, call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. If in eyes, hold eyes open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.</p> <p><u>Precautionary Statement:</u> Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed. <p>Momentum FX²</p>	<p>2,4-D, 3,5,6-Trichloro-2-Pyridinyloxyacetic Acid, 1-Methylheptyl Ester of Fluroxypyr</p>	<p><u>Statement of Practical Treatment:</u> If in eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or physician for treatment advice. If swallowed: Call a Poison Control Center immediately for treatment advice. Have individual sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a Poison Control Center</p> <p><u>Precautionary Statement:</u> Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes or on clothing.</p> <p><u>Environmental hazards:</u> This product may be toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. If inhaled, remove individual to fresh air, and get medical attention. If on skin, wash with plenty of soap and water, and get medical attention. If in eyes, flush with plenty of water and call a physician if irritation persists.</p> <p><u>Precautionary Statement:</u> Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing.</p> <p><u>Environmental Hazards:</u> This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Drift and runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. <p>Tenacity</p>	<p>Mesotrione</p>	<p><u>Statement of Practical Treatment:</u> If on skin or clothing, remove contaminated clothing and rinse skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician if irritation persists. If swallowed, call a Poison Control Center immediately, and provide individual with water to sip. If in eyes, hold eyelids open and rinse slowly and gently for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician if irritation persists. If inhaled, remove individual to fresh air.</p> <p><u>Precautionary Statement:</u> Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.</p> <p><u>Environmental Hazards:</u> Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below mean high water mark. If in eyes, immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention promptly.</p> <p><u>Precautionary Statement:</u> Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. The effectiveness of this product is reduced when grass clippings interfere with thorough spray coverage of the target weeds.</p>
